Martha Norton Hill, RN, PhD, FAAN, Dean at the Johns Hopkins University School of Nursing in Baltimore, Maryland, is a world-renowned researcher, educator, and nursing leader. Internationally known for developing and testing strategies to improve hypertension care and control among urban, underserved African-Americans, Dr. Hill has served as the only non-physician president of the American Heart Association in its 80+ year history—placing her in one of the highest regarded positions in the field of cardiology. Among her honors, Dr. Hill was presented the Nell J. Watts Lifetime Achievement in Nursing Award from Sigma Theta Tau International in 2003.
